Two U.S. Senators from Alaska, top government and military officials, international partners, research scientists and representatives from the oil and shipping industries will speak at the 5th Symposium on the Impacts of an Ice-Diminishing Arctic on Naval and Maritime Operations, July 16-18, 2013, at the Navy Heritage Center, 701 Pennsylvania Ave, N.W., Washington, DC.

The symposium, co-hosted by the U.S. National/Naval Ice Center (NIC) and the U.S. Arctic Research Commission (USARC), will address the changing state of Arctic sea ice and associated environmental conditions that are impacting naval, maritime and other critical activities in the region.
