





US Health & Human Services

 Free on-site and distance Technical Assistance and Training (TAT) to <u>drinking water and</u> <u>wastewater systems in low income communities</u>.

Technitrain

- Free on-site and distance TAT to drinking water, wastewater and solid waste systems, including grant and loan applications, as approved by USDA RD in AK.
- Free GIS mapping of a system's <u>drinking water</u> and <u>wastewater assets</u>.

RCAC's Funding Sources for Environmental Services in Alaska

EPA1

- Free on-site and distance compliance assistance for <u>Technical capacity to drinking water systems</u>
- Includes for profit systems.

EPA3

 Free on-site and distance compliance assistance for <u>Technical</u>, <u>Managerial and Financial capacity</u> <u>to wastewater systems</u>.
